<u>Payroll</u>

- 1. (Q-12/19/23) Maine State Taxes -- Program changes were made to accommodate changes in the Maine State Tax tables.
- 2. (Q-12/19/23) Iowa State Taxes -- Program changes were made to accommodate changes in the Iowa State Tax tables. The 2024 IA W-4 lets employees have different allowance amounts. Enter those amounts into the State Exemption Amount field on the Tax tab in Enter/Modify Employees.
- 3. (R-12/26/23) W2 Electronic File -- When creating the W2 electronic file, if you chose to write the W2REPORT.TXT to a different folder, the file name was frequently truncated and/or not written to the correct folder.
- 4. (R-1/5/24) Accruals Add-On -- If you selected the Begin Use Date for Vacation from the calendar look-up button, the date selected was placed into the Begin Use Date for Sick Leave. Typing the date into the field worked correctly.
- 5. (R-1/7/24) North Dakota State Taxes -- Program changes were made to accommodate changes in the North Dakota Tax tables.
- 6. (R-1/12/24) Void Checks -- The Hours Pending field for Accruals was not being updated when a check was voided.
- 7. (R-1/21/24) W2 Printing -- The option to truncate SSN's when printing was not working.
- 8. (R-3/18/24) Tracked Non-Wages -- If you were calculating a batch of checks, and you used the Employee ID look-up to change to a different employee record, if one of the employees used tracking amounts, and the other employee didn't, the tracking amount relating to one of the checks could be incorrect.
